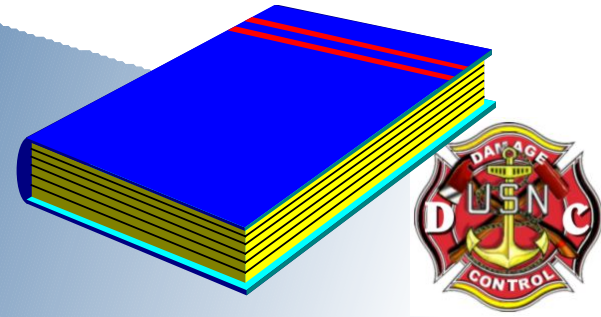

Damage Control Schools



- DCA SE (A-4G-1111)
 - ↪ 1 PER SHIP (*Likely that multiple members will have attended*)
- REPAIR PARTY LEADER (K-495-0040)
 - ↪ ALL RPLS AND RLOS
 - ↪ PREREQUISITES
 - ADV FIRE FIGHTING (K-495-0419)
 - ↪ SUBSTITUTE COURSES
 - DCASE
 - SENIOR ENLISTED DC (A-495-2055) = NO LONGER EXIST!!



Damage Control Schools



- GFE/GFEA, GFEPO (K-495-0051)
 - ↪ 1 GFE/1GFEA PER SHIP AND A GFEPO FOR EACH DUTY SECTION
 - ↪ E-4 AND ABOVE
 - ↪ SUBSTITUTES: DCASE



FIREFIGHTING SCHOOLS



- **GENERAL SHIPBOARD FIRE FIGHTING (J-495-0412)**

- ↳ **ALL HANDS REQUIRED AND REPEATED EVERY 6 YEARS**

- ↳ **AUTHORIZED SUBSTITUTES**

- AIRCRAFT FIRE FIGHTING (0413)
- HELO FIRE FIGHTING (0414)
- FIRE FIGHTING TEAM TRNG (0418)
- ADVANCED FIRE FIGHTING (0419)
- RECRUIT F/F

- ↳ **0416 Course for SCBA equipped ships**



FIREFIGHTING SCHOOLS



- AIRCRAFT F/F EVALUATION (J-495-0413)
 - ↪ LHA, LHD, & MCS SHIPS ONLY
 - ↪ FLIGHT DECK PERSONNEL, PILOTS, AIRCREW
 - ↪ WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF ASSIGNMENT
 - ↪ EVERY 4 YEARS THEREAFTER
- HELO F/F EVALUATION (J-495-0414)
 - ↪ FLT DECK TEAMS FOR LPD'S AND SMALLER
 - ↪ REPEATED EVERY 2 YEARS OR 40% TURNOVER
- F/F TEAM TRAINING (J-495-0418)
 - ↪ ALL LOCKERS AND IETS
 - ↪ Once per IDTC, NTE 24 months



FIREFIGHTING SCHOOLS



- ADVANCED SHIPBOARD FIRE FIGHTING (J-495-0419)
 - ↪ REQUIRED FOR ALL SCENE LEADERS AND REPAIR PARTY LEADERS
 - ↪ PREREQUISITE FOR REPAIR PARTY LEADER



DAMAGE CONTROL SCHOOLS



- GENERAL SHIPBOARD DAMAGE CONTROL (K-495-0045)
 - ↪ REQUIRED FOR ALL LOCKER AND IET TEAM MEMBERS
 - ↪ NO MORE THAN 24 MONTHS BETWEEN COURSES
- A-495-0400 DAMAGE CONTROL PETTY OFFICER STEP CD-ROM (NKO Watertight closure course will be online "soon")
 - MINIMUM OF ONE PER DIVISION ONBOARD
- FOAM GENERATING SYSTEMS MAINTENANCE (K-495-2179)

• GETTING ENOUGH QUOTAS.

- ↪ Who is schools coordinator?
- ↪ Schools coordinator contacts quota control
- ↪ Use of CANTRAC and Messages

• GETTING YOUR PERSONNEL THROUGH THE SCHOOLS

- ↪ PERSONAL involvement
- ↪ Go to the school
- ↪ Deconflict with operational schedule of ship

• DOCUMENTATION

- ↪ NITRAS
- ↪ Admin shortfalls
- ↪ COMPASS tracking



Summary



- DCA should track schools requirements through SURFORTRAMAN to remain current
- DCA should determine what courses should be required in event of IDTC or deployment to remain current
- Schedule schools and GET INVOLVED to ensure timely arrival and completion
